CHECKLIST

- □ Valid passport: If you need a visa, apply for it well in advance.
- D Prescriptions (optical and general); extra medication (recommended)
- □ Bring at least 350 € in cash: You will need it to purchase the ticket and to cover other living expenses during your first days in Munich (Mensa card, etc.)
- Credit card (MasterCard/VISA), debit card (Maestro/EC), or traveler's checks
- □ International health/accident insurance
- Toiletry brands may differ from those in your home country, so you may want to bring your own.
- □ Please bring your own towels, as they will not be provided for you.
- Photocopies of your passport and other important documents: Never carry your original passport with you unless you are traveling.
- The temperature in Germany during the summer time varies between 15 and 35 degrees. Please bring also some warm clothing and shoes for rain.

Public Transport with the S-Bahn from the Airport to the Welcome Reception (*Deutschkurse*, Agnesstr. 27, 80798 München):

Departure:every 10 minutes (trip should require 60 minutes)Fare:49,00 € (49-EUR-Ticket)

Follow the "S-Bahn" sign



- take S8 or S1 / get off at the station "Hauptbahnhof"
- take subway U2 in direction of "Feldmoching"
- get off at the station "Josephsplatz".
- Take the exit towards Adelheidstraße / Georgenstraße. Go along Adelheidstraße and at the second crossing turn left into Agnesstraße. The office is just 2 walking-minutes away on the left side of the street.

Arrival by train (central station):

Fare: 49,00 € (49-EUR-Ticket) At the Munich main station ("Hauptbahnhof") follow the "U-Bahn" or "U2"

- take subway U2 in direction of "Feldmoching"
- get off at the station "Josephsplatz".
- Take the exit towards Adelheidstraße / Georgenstraße. Go along Adelheidstraße and at the second crossing turn left into Agnesstraße. The office is just 2 walking-minutes away on the left side of the street.



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

For the use of public transport in Munich (S-Bahn, U-Bahn, inner-city buses, tram) we recommend the 49 EUR-ticket at a price of 49,00 € per month. This ticket offers the great opportunity that passengers nationwide can use public transport for onlv 49.00 euros per month. https://int.bahn.de/en/offers/regional/deutschland-ticket

Very important: as the Deutschlandticket is automatically renewed, we strongly recommend that you immediately after purchasing the subscription cancel it. In this way the subscription will only be valid for one month.

ELECTRICITY



In Germany, electronic devices run at 220 -230V with a frequency of 50 Hz. Please make sure that your plugs fit a type C or type F socket! If not, please consider purchasing an electronic adapter before your arrival.

PHONE / MOBILE INTERNET

Call Shops: Probably the cheapest way to make phone calls is using the Call Shops near central station (Hauptbahnhof).

Cell Phones: Of course, you can also check with your current cell phone provider if it would be financially feasible to change your current contract accordingly.

Prepaid Cards: SIM-cards with a German number which can be used with your own cell phone. Such cards can be bought at supermarkets (approx. € 10.00). Please note: Most of the SIM-cards are no micro SIM-cards (you need for iPhone, e.g.).

INSURANCE

Health Insurance:

Please note that you need health insurance in Germany.

Accident Insurance:

Please note that participants are not insured against accidents which occur on the campus of the "Deutschkurse" (Agnesstraße 27 and Karl-Theodor-Straße 69), the "LMU" or during an excursion with the program.

The participation in the excursions is at one's own risk. Thus, we strongly recommend a private insurance against accidents if you do not have one already.

If you have no insurances we recommend the Students, Trainees, Language Students insurance from www.klemmer-international.com which includes health and accident insurance for 1.00 € a day.

EATING & REFRESHMENTS ON CAMPUS

Mensa / Dining Hall:

The *Mensa* (dining hall) offers students a variety of reasonably priced and nutritious meals: this includes a choice of vegetarian and pork-free meals, a salad and antipasti bar, fresh juices, desserts sweets and ice-cream. A meal costs between 2 and 8 €.

Legic Card:

In the Mensa you will have to pay with the so-called Legic-Card (i. e. Cafeteria Card), a chip-based multifunctional card used for cash-free payments. Each Legic-Card costs $12 \in$ that comprises a $5 \in$ -credit and a $7 \in$ -security deposit. You can get the Legic-Card at the Infopoint and the service offices in the dining hall. Please pay attention to the opening hours of each dining hall.

SPORTS ACTIVITIES

In Germany the sport locations of the university are restricted to long-term students of Munich. We can recommend you some possibilities open to the public.

Outdoor activities:

Munich has a lot of large parks, such as the English Garden, the Olympic Park or the Luitpold Park. These green areas are great for jogging, playing soccer or other outdoor activities.

Biking:

Munich is an excellent city for biking. Bikes can be rented for day trips (Radverleih i. HBf., Hauptbahnhof), or you may want to look into buying a used bicycle (Secondhand Sports, Nymphenburger Straße 25). (http://www.radiustours.com/en/english-tours/bike-tour.html)

Swimming:

There are a variety of excellent public swimming halls around Munich, for example the Olympia-Swimmhalle (Olympic Swimming Hall) at Coubertinplatz 1. Other possibilities and prices are available at: https://www.swm.de/english/m-baeder/prices

Tennis:

One possibility to play tennis is at the courts of Olympic Centre (Spiridon-Louis-Ring 21), where tennis rackets may be rented. The prices vary between $11 \in$ and $20 \in$ depending on the time of day and which day of the week. You should make a reservation beforehand by calling (089) 3067 2689. Gym:
